Novice singer

- Can sing in tune
- Have experience with singing in groups and listening to others
- Have experience with reading notes
- Are preferably familiar with singing Latin texts
- Preferably read Gregorian notation

Novice conductors

- Are experienced ensemble singers: sing in tune with good attention to their fellow singers
- Read music notation well and are familiar with singing Latin lyrics
- Preferably read Gregorian notation
- Preferably already have some experience with conducting

Advanced singers

- Are experienced ensemble singers: sing in tune with good attention to their fellow singers
- Have experience in singing Gregorian chant repertoire
- Are familiar with Gregorian notation and can sight read this notation properly
- Have a good basic knowledge of semiology in the notation of Skt.Gallen and Metz.
- Preferably have some knowledge of Beneventine and Acquitine manuscripts.

Advanced conductors

- Have experience in leading a Gregorian chanting group
- To have a good basic technique of conducting
- Have a good knowledge of the liturgical context of Gregorian chant
- Are experienced ensemble singers: sing in tune with good attention to their fellow singers
- Are familiar with Gregorian notation and can sight read this notation properly
- Have a good basic knowledge of semiology in the notation of Skt.Gallen and Metz.
